LET THE LAWN CARE SEASON BEGIN

Spring is right around the corner, and March is the perfect time to kick off the lawn care season! As the weather warms up, your yard is ready to wake up and shine. Not sure where to start? Here are a few things you can do this month to set your lawn up for success:

- Remove any winter damage. Any branches, leaves, dirt, etc. laying on top of your grass should be removed. These branches and weeds are going to start taking advantage of a weak lawn. They need to be removed.
- Prepare your mower and lawn tools. Your tools have likely been sitting in your garage or shed for a few months. Pull them out and clean them up. Make sure they work and are ready to go when it's time to start using them.
- Aerate. If you have warm-season grass (Bermuda, zoysia, St. Augustine), you should have your lawn aerated in early spring every year. This is really where the "lawn calendar year" starts. It's the foundation for a healthy, thick lawn.



It's likely your lawn is fine and does not need mowing yet because it hasn't started growing for the season. But if you do feel your lawn is ready to be mowed, just take off very little from the top.



- Clean Up & Refresh Clear away any leftover leaves and debris to give your grass room to breathe.
- Check Your Irrigation—Make sure your sprinklers are in top shape before the heat arrives.
- Feed & Seed A little fertilizer and some overseeding can work wonders for a lush, green lawn.
- >> Mow with Care Your first few mows should be light to encodrage strong growth.
